They are delighted that you are here today. Thank you for your presence and participation on this special day.
PRESENTATION OF BRIDE: Who gives their blessing for this marriage?
MARRIAGE MESSAGE: and, today you are affirming before witnesses of earth and heaven that you believe God has intended that you should share life in the holy union of matrimony. Your marriage must stand by the strength of your love and the power of faith in each other and in Jesus Christ. There is no relationship on earth as intimate or meaningful as those you are about to enter. There is no human institution more sacred than that of the home you are about to form. The life that each of you experienced now, individually, will hereafter be inseparably united, for the two shall become one flesh. Christian marriage is based on this deep, invisible union of two souls who seek to find completion in one another. Solomon said that a cord of three strands is not easily broken, so too your two lives when merged together and entwined with Christ will make a beautiful marriage that is strengthened by Gods love. This is the core of your marriage and why you are here today. It will take trust, to know in your hearts that you truly want the best for each other. It will take dedication, to stay open and honest with one another - and to learn and grow together. It will take faith, to go forward together without knowing exactly what the future brings. And it will take commitment, to hold true to the journey you both promised today to share together. Just as there will never be a morning without the ocean's flow, there will never be a day without your love for each other. You have just sealed your relationship by the giving and receiving of rings. You have committed here today to share the rest of your lives with each other. This beautiful union is symbolized through the combining of these two individual shells of sand. The first shell represents you, and all that you were, all that you are, and all that you will ever be, and the other represents you, and all that you were, all that you are and all that you will ever be. Each one holds its own unique beauty, strength, and character. They can stand on their own and be whole, without need of anything else. However when these two are blended together they create an entirely new and extraordinarily more intricate entity.
